1. Students / Artistes (200 number) @ Rs 20,000/- or as per actual whichever is less will be supported (once in a year)

Procedure for submission of application:

Application from individual / institution will be accepted

Eligibility:

- (i) Students of Government Dance College, Shree Shree Bal Mukunda Dev Music College, Imphal Art College, Manipur University of Culture, Jawaharlal Nehru Manipur Dance Academy and Manipur University (Dance, Music and Fine Art Department) and deserving budding artistes recommended by the Screening Committee
- (ii) Applicant should be pursuing a course in one of the art forms
- (iii) Applicant should be below 30 years of age
- (iv) A student may avail benefit of this scheme twice during his studentship with a gap of one year.
- (v) The extent of financial assistance will be decided by the Screening Committee
